At Easter we celebrate with iou Christ's triumph over the powers of sin and death, and the promise of eternal life in which we now share. At this time Christ appeared to his disciples over the course of forty days, speaking to them about the kinadom of God. Followina this he ascended to sit at the right hand of the Father, until he shall return in great glory at the last day. The disciples remained in Jerusalem in an upper room, together with certain women. devoting themselves to prayer. On the fiftieth day, while they were all gathered the Holy Spirit came upon them with tongues of fire, leading them to proclaim the Gospel in the languages of all the nations. Sent forth in the power of the Spirit, they went out continuing the ministry of Jesus in teaching, healing and building the Church throughout the world.

Today let us meditate on this story of our faith. As we hear again how Christ was raised from the dead let us, with the apostles, cast off our fear and doubt in the hope of the resurrection. As we hear of his ascension, let our spirits be raised. And as we hear of the aift of the Spirit let us prau for the fruits of the Spirit, which are love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control; and through them praise God who is Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

In the joy of the resurrection, let us pray to the Father in the words our Saviour gave us:

ΑΠ Our Father. who art in heaven. hallowed be thu name: thu kingdom come; thu will be done; on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom, the power and the glory, for ever and ever. Amen.

Easter Reading

A reading from the Gospel according to St Mark.

When the sabbath was over, Maru Maadalene, and Maru the mother of James, and Salome bought spices, so that they might go and anoint him. And very early on the first day of the week, when the sun had risen, they went to the tomb. They had been saying to one another, Who will roll away the stone for us from the entrance to the tomb?' When they looked up, they saw that the stone, which was very large, had already been rolled back. As they entered the tomb, they saw a

young man, dressed in a white robe, sitting on the right side; and they were alarmed. But he said to them. 'Do not be alarmed; you are looking for Jesus of Nazareth, who was crucified. He has been raised; he is not here. Look, there is the place they laid him. But go, tell his disciples and Peter that he is going ahead of you to Galilee; there you will see him, just as he told you.' So they went out and fled from the tomb, for terror and amazement had seized them; and they said nothing to anyone, for they were afraid. And all that had been commanded them they told brieflu to those around Peter. And afterwards Jesus himself sent out through them, from east to west, the sacred and imperishable proclamation of eternal salvation.

Please stand as you are able.

Lord, enthroned in heavenly splendour, first-begotten from the dead, thou alone, our strong defender, liftest up thy people's head. Alleluia, alleluia, Jesu, true and living bread!

Here our humblest homage pay we; here in loving reverence bow. Here for faith's discernment pray we, lest we fail to know thee now. Alleluia, alleluia, thou art here, we ask not how. Though the lowliest form doth veil thee as of old in Bethlehem, here as there thine angels hail thee, branch and flower of Jesse's stem. Alleluia, alleluia, we in worship join with them.

A reading from the book of the Acts of the Apostles.

When the disciples had come together, they asked him, 'Lord, is this the time when you will restore the kingdom to Israel?' He replied, 'It is not for you to know the times or periods that the Father has set by his own authority. But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon uou; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth 'When he had said this, as they were watching, he was lifted up, and a cloud took him out of their sight. While he was going and they were gazing up towards heaven, suddenly two men in white robes stood by them. They said, 'Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking up towards heaven? This Jesus, who has been taken up from you into heaven, will come in the same way as you saw him go into heaven."

Reading for Pentecost

A reading from the Gospel of John.

Jesus said to the disciples: When the Advocate comes, whom I will send to you from the Father, the Spirit of truth who comes from the Father, he will testify on my behalf. You also are to testify because you have been with me from the beginning. I tell you the truth: it is to your advantage that I go away, for if I do not go away, the Advocate will not come to you; but if I go, I will send him

to you. And when he comes, he will prove the world wrong about sin and righteousness and judgement: about sin. because they do not believe in me; about righteousness, because I am going to the Father and you will see me no longer; about judgement, because the ruler of this world has been condemned. I still have many things to say to you, but you cannot bear them now. When the Spirit of truth comes, he will quide you into all the truth: for he will not speak on his own, but will speak whatever he hears, and he will declare to you the things that are to come.

A reading from the letter to the Ephesians.

I therefore, the prisoner in the Lord, beg you to lead a life worthy of the calling to which you have been called, with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love, making every effort to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to the one hope of your calling, one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God and Father of all, who is above all and through all and in all. But each of us was given grace according to the measure of Christ's gift. Therefore it is said, 'When he ascended on high he made captivity itself a captive; he gave gifts to his people.'
